BOOK OF ACTS TIMELINE

- 30 – 33 AD – Ac 1-6 Persecution only of apostles by Jews, 3 yrs.
33 – 36 AD – Ac 7 Persecution of church by Jews begins, with Paul 3 yrs.
36 – 39 AD – Ac 8-9a 3 conversions, Simeon, Ethiopian Eunuch, Paul
– Paul goes to Arabia for 3 yrs. Gal.1:17,18;
- 39 – 42 AD – Ac 9b-11 3 acts of Peter – 2 miracles, Cornelius, defense
42 – 45 AD – Ac 12 3 acts of Herod – Paul goes to Antioch for 3 years.
– James & Matthew are written around this time.
- 45 – 48 AD – Ac 13,14 Paul's first missionary journey 3 yrs.
48 – 51 AD – Ac 15 Paul in Antioch 3yrs then Jer. council 51 AD
51 – 54 AD – Ac 16-18a Paul's second missionary journey 3 yrs.
– 1 & 2 Thessalonians written from Corinth.
- 54 – 57 AD – Ac 18b – 20 Paul's third missionary journey 3 yrs
– Galatians, 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians, Romans written from Ephesus
- 57 – 60 AD – Ac 21-23 Paul has 3 trials before Jews, 3 trials before Gentiles
60 – 63 AD – Ac 27-28 Paul shipwrecked then 2 yrs prison in Rome
– Ephesians, Colossians, Philippians, Philemon written from prison
– Luke , Acts written by Luke
- 63 – 66 AD – Paul released writes 1 Timothy , Titus, Hebrews, from Macedonia
66 AD – Paul arrested writes 2 Timothy then executed 66 AD?
63 -65 AD – Mark, 1 & 2 Peter, Jude written
67 – 70 AD – Destruction of Jerusalem by Romans
70 – 80 AD – John writes John, 1,2,3 John, Revelation – Revelation 17:10-11

1/3 Means “First of three”

30 AD

- 3 Destinations For The Gospel - Ac.1
 - Jerusalem - Judea/Samaria – World
- 3 Admonitions / 3 Persecutions, in 3 Years - Ac.2-7
 - 1st Admonition - Get rid of sin. Repent and be baptized.
 - Numerical growth Ac.2:41-47;
 - 1/3 of Peter's sermons - Ac.2:14-40; 3:12-26; 10:34-48;
 - 1st Persecution - Ac.3:1f Sanhedrin arrests Peter/John
 - Spiritual growth - Ac.4:31
 - Warned not to speak or teach in the name of Jesus - Ac.4:18;
 - 2nd Admonition - Ac.5:1-16; Get rid of hypocrisy – Ananias/Sapphira
 - Numerical growth - Ac.5:14
 - 2nd Persecution - Ac.5:17-42; Sanhedrin jails the apostles
 - Spiritual growth - Ac.5:41;
 - Re-arrested, Gamaliel defends - beaten - then released.
 - Speak no more in the name of Jesus.
 - 1/3 Miraculous jail breaks - Ac.12:7; 16:27;
 - 3rd Admonition - Ac.6:1-7; Get rid of partiality - Hellenistic widows
 - Numerical growth - Ac.6:7;

33 AD

- 1/3 - 7 good men - Ac.11:12; 20:4;
- 3rd Persecution - Ac.6:8:7:60; Sanhedrin kills Stephen.
 - Spiritual growth - church was scattered.
 - 1/3 Martyrs - Ac.12:1-3; James; Ac.14:19; Paul
- 3 CONVERSIONS - Ac.8:1 – 9:30;
 - Simon the Magician - Ac.8:1-25;
 - 1/3 Magicians Ac.13:8; Bar/Jesus; Ac.19:19; Ephesus
 - Ethiopian Eunuch - Ac.8:26-40;
 - Saul Ac.9:3-19; blind for 3 days. 36 AD
 - 1/3 Paul's conversion - Ac.22:3-21; 26:1-20;
 - 1/3 Plots to kill Paul - Ac.20:3; 23:12-14;

36 AD

- Saul to Arabia 3 yrs. Gal.1:17; 18; Ac.9:26-30; 36 - 39 AD

39 AD

- Saul to Tarsus 3 yrs. Gal.1:21; Ac.11:25; 39 - 42 AD
- 3 ACTS OF PETER - Ac.9:31 – 11:18;
 - Miracles - heals Aeneas/ raises Dorcas - Ac.9:36-43;
 - 1/3 resurrections Ac.14:20; 20:9;
 - Cornelius 10:1ff - vision 3 times - 3 men arrive, 40 AD
 - 1/3 acts human worship Ac.12:22,23; 14:11-15;

- Defends Gentile conversion in Jerusalem Ac.11:1-18;
- Missions converge on Antioch - Ac.11:19-30
 - Men from Cyprus and Cyrene - Ac.11:20;
 - Jerusalem sends Barnabas - Ac.11:22;
 - Barnabas gets Saul - 42-45 AD - Ac.11:26;

42 AD

- 3 ACTS OF HEROD - Ac.12
 - Kills James the brother of John Ac.12:1,2;
 - Imprisons Peter. Ac.12:3-19;
 - Herod dies for accepting worship Ac.12:20-24; 44AD

44 AD

- Matthew and James are written around this time.

45-48 AD

- 1ST MISSIONARY JOURNEY - Ac.13-14
 - 3 Missionaries - Barnabas, Saul, Mark
 - 3 Stops
 - Cyprus - Proconsul Sergius Paulus impressed. Ac.13:7;
 - Saul has name changed to Paul Ac.13:9;
 - 1/3 authorities see Christianity as innocent - Ac.18:12-17; 19:41;
 - Pisidian Antioch - Paul's first recorded sermon Ac.13:16-41;
 - 1/3 sermons of Paul - Ac.18:16-41; 17:22-31; 20:18-35;
 - 3 Point Sermon to the Jews of Pisidian Antioch:
 - 3 times God delivered His people
 - 3 witnesses for Jesus to be the Messiah
 - 3 scriptures to prove the resurrection of the Lord.
 - Lystra - the stoning of Paul - Ac.14:19.20;
 - Paul and Barnabas returned to Antioch for 3 yrs. 48 - 51 AD

AD 51

- JERUSALEM COUNCIL - Ac.15
 - 3 Defend Gospel Given to Gentiles - Jerusalem Council
 - Peter; Paul & Barnabas; James Ac.15:7-13;
 - 3 Things for Gentiles to abstain from:
 - Idolatry; Fornication; Blood. Ac.15:29;
 - 1/3 letters written, Ac.15:23; 18:27; 23:

51-54 AD

- 2ND MISSIONARY JOURNEY - Ac.16:1-18:21;
 - 3 Missionaries - Paul, Silas, Timothy
 - 3 Cities Paul visits:
 - Derbe; Lystra (Tim.) Troas (Luke)
 - 3 Messages from the HS: Ac.16:6-10;

- Don't go to Asia vs.6
- Don't go to Bithynia vs.7
- Told go to Macedonia vs.10
- 3 Souls in Philippi: Ac.16:15,18,33;
 - Lydia; Slave girl; Jailer
 - 1/3 officials afraid for breaking law - Ac.19:40; 22:29;
- 3 Important cities in Macedonia:
 - Philippi; Thessalonica; Berea
- 3 Last cities of Journey:
 - Athens; (Paul writes 1 / 2 Thessalonians) Corinth; Ephesus
- 3 Point sermon to worldly souls in Athens: Ac.17:22-31;
 - God is Creator of all. Ac.17:22,23;
 - God is Within reach of all. Ac.17:27-29;
 - God will Judge all. Ac.17:30,31;
- 3 Brethren in Corinth:
 - Aquilla/Priscilla; Titius Justus; Crispus
 - 1/3 Jesus speaks to Paul Ac.9:4-6; 19:9,10; 23:11;
 - Paul returns to Antioch, only to leave shortly on 3rd journey.

54-57 AD

- 3RD Missionary Journey - Ac.18:21 - 20
 - Apollos meets Priscilla/Aquila in Ephesus
- 3 R's to remember Ephesus by:
 - Re-baptism of 12 disciples Ac.19:1-7;
 - Rejection of 7 sons of Sceva Ac.19:8-20;
 - Riot of Demetrius the Silversmith. Ac.19:23-41;
 - Paul writes – Romans, 1 / 2 Corinthians, Galatians
- 3 Stops for Paul on trip to Jerusalem:
 - Corinth - plot discovered Ac.20:1-5;
 - Troas - Eutychus, 3rd floor Ac.20:6-16;
 - Miletus - sermon to elders Ac.20:17ff
- 3 Point sermon to Ephesian Elders:
 - Paul's example - taught whole Truth. Ac.20:18-27;
 - Paul's warning - false teachers rise up Ac.20:28-31;
 - Paul's admonition - be grounded in Truth Ac.20:31-35'
- 3 Warnings to Paul, not to go to Jerusalem - Ac.21:1-14;
 - The disciples at Tyre - Ac.21:4;
 - Agabus from Judea - Ac.21:11;
 - The disciples at Caesarea - Ac.21:12;

57-60 AD

- PAUL ARRESTED 6 TRIALS - Ac.21 - 26
- 3 Rescues by Lysias the Commander
 - At the temple - Ac.21:27 - 40;
 - Before Sanhedrin - Ac.23:10;
 - From Assassins - Ac.23:12-35;

- 3 Trials before the Jews - Ac.22,23,23
 - At the temple - Ac. 22:1-22;
 - Before the Sanhedrin - Ac.23:1-10;
 - Aborted trial because of plot - Ac.23:12-35;
- 3 Trials before Gentiles - Ac.24,25,26
 - Before Felix - Ac.24:1-27; Jails Paul two yrs.
 - Before Festus - Ac. 25:1-12; Appeals to Caesar
 - Before Agrippa - Ac.26:1-32;

60-63 AD

- PAUL'S JOURNEY AND HOUSE ARREST IN ROME
- 3 Landings - Sidon, Myra, Fair Havens - Ac.27:1-8;
- 3 Admonitions from Paul - Ac.27:9-44
 - Paul warns of impending danger. Ac.27:10;
 - Paul warns of shipwreck but all will survive. Ac.27:21-26;
 - Paul encourages them to eat. Ac.27:33-35;
- 3 Months on Malta - Ac.28:1-10;
- 3 City Stops Before Rome
 - Syracuse (3 days) Rhegium, Puteoli
 - Paul spent two years under house arrest: Ac.28:30,31;
 - Welcoming all who came to him
 - Preaching the kingdom of God
 - Teaching concerning the Lord Jesus Christ
 - Paul writes – Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, Philemon; Luke writes Luke, Acts

63 AD

- Paul was released. Re-arrested 2 years later.

PAUL NEEDED TO LEARN ABOUT LOVE

Saul's persecution of the church. Acts 8:1-3
Acts 22:3-5; 26:9-11; Galatians 1:13-17; 1 Timothy 1:13-16
Saul's conversion. Acts 9:1-18; 22:6-13

Saul went to Arabia for 3 years why? Learn love.
Acts 9:19-25; His early preaching amazed the Jews because he became a Christian

Confounded the Jews so they decided to kill him.
Confounded = SUGXEW – pour together, confuse, confound, trouble, throw in consternation, agitate

1 Corinthians 13:1-3; if I do not have love -then I am a noisy gong, nothing, profit nothing, Confounding!
Let down in a basket – to Arabia for 3 years – Galatians 1:17-18

When Paul returned he no longer CONFOUNDED but he:
REASONED – DIALOEGOMAI – discuss, address
Acts 17:2,17; 18:4,19; 19:8-9
PERSUADED – PEITHO – persuade, have confidence
Acts 17:4; 18:4; 19:8,26; 21:13-14; 26:26-28; 28:23-24

How much more new Christians do we take time to teach them about love or push them to evangelize.
If Paul needed three years how much more new Christians.

Apostles studied 3 years under Jesus, who endured persecution.
Church studied 3 years under Apostles, who endured persecution.
Paul studied 3 years under Jesus, then endured the persecution.

Timothy studied 3 years under the church, then joined with Paul. Acts 14:8; 16:1

First 3 years of a Christians life vital, to prepare them to go to work with Christ.
